\*\*For junior races, prize list will be for overall finishers. LAJORS medals will be given to top 3 in each age group.

\*\*\*Children's Races are free to enter, but must register and have an approved helmet. All participants will receive recognition. CHILDREN'S AGE GROUPS (Distance): Ages 4 and younger (50 meters), 5-9 (100 Meters). JUNIORS AGE GROUPS (NOT part of the LAJORS Series): 10-12 and 13-14 (1 lap).

The Lance Armstrong Junior Olympic Road Series (LAJORS) program promotes quality junior and espoir age bicycle racing while providing opportunities for the success and advancement of developing riders. This program helps to provide a clear path for riders to follow from beginning racing experiences through training camps to National Teams. Athletes ages 15 to 22 will have the opportunity to qualify for USA Cycling Regional Camps by finishing in the top five places of LAJORS races. For details, visit: <http://www.usacycling.org/lajors>

\*\*\*\*Espoir racers will compete in the Men's Pro Cat 1/2/3 event, but will be scored separately.

**COURSE:** One-mile loop though historic cycling venue, Sherman Park, on Chicago's South Side. Start/Finish and registration is on the North side of the course off of 52<sup>nd</sup> Street.

**REGISTRATION:** Race-day registration begins at 6:30 AM and closes 15 minutes before each event. Racers will save \$5.00 when competing in a second event.

**DIRECTIONS / PARKING:** By Car - I 90/94 (Dan Ryan Expw) exit at Garfield (5500 South), head West on Garfield, 52<sup>nd</sup> and other nearby streets where legally allowed. By CTA - take the Redline to Garfield stop. Go approximately one mile West on Garfield. Sherman Park is on your right. Sherman Park is also serviced by CTA bus route #55 Garfield.

All USA Cycling rules apply.

Riders must wear a helmet whenever you are on a bicycling during this event.
